KENT CABINETY PLANS **NEW "ZERO-ENERGY" LOCATION**

Chestertown, Md., February 7, 2010 – **Kent Cabinetry & Millwork, Inc**, a custom cabinet and millwork firm in Chestertown, announces plans to begin construction of a new 3700-square-foot building to house its operations. The company currently serves customers at 9944 Fairlee Road in Chestertown.

Owner Matt Clark is pleased with plans for the new building, which will be located on Route 213 between Church Hill and Centreville.

Clark commented, "A critical factor is to lower overhead expenses, and this consideration has driven the design and size." The building will be erected to be near-zero energy for heating and cooling by using solar power and Structural Insulated Wall Panels. Photovoltaic solar electric panels will provide a near-zero electric bill and hopefully will be a prototype for future commercial buildings.

Design engineer Robert Randall, an MIT graduate, will assist on this project. His company, **Randall Engineering**, specializes in zero-energy buildings. Construction is due to begin in May, with completion planned in July.

The new building will feature a showroom to assist customers in choosing cabinet styles and finishes, and show examples of completed projects. A large selection of custom moldings made by the shop will also be on display. The remaining space will house the workshop and office space.

Kent Cabinetry fabricates quality custom cabinets for kitchen, bath, entertainment centers and home offices; and also specializes in architectural millwork. They also can make radius doors for convex or concave cabinets. They use custom molding to accent their cabinetry and often design a new molding just for one project.
